

## **Voter Information**

### **Proof of identity**

Any elector wishing to record his vote shall produce his National Identity Card, passport, driving licence, or bus pass.

### **Website and SMS**

Any elector who wishes to know the polling station and the voting room where he votes, can click on the link “Polling Station Where You Vote” at <http://electoral.govmu.org>

The same information may be obtained through sms by typing ‘elec’ (space) and the national identity card number and send to 789 for Orange, Emtel and MTML.

### **Voting**

Polling stations in all the wards will open at 7.00 a.m. and close at 6.00 p.m.

An elector may vote for not more than 4 candidates.

The use of mobile phones, camera, any other photographic or electronic devices in voting and counting rooms is strictly prohibited.

### **SNVR**

Arrangements have been made for the provision of a voting room on the ground floor at each polling station to facilitate electors with disabilities and special needs to cast their votes.

A person with disabilities may cast his vote if he so wishes with the assistance of an adult member of his family namely his father, mother, brother, sister, husband, wife, son or daughter.
