Order made by the Electoral Supervisory Commission re: date of coming into force of register of electors 2024

The register of electors for the year 2024 has been compiled on the basis of the new boundaries of the constituencies, as recommended in the 2020 Report of the Electoral Boundaries Commission. The recommendations were approved by the National Assembly on 19 December 2023.

Pursuant to Section 39(4) of the Constitution, the recommendations shall have effect as from the next dissolution of the National Assembly.

The Electoral Supervisory Commission has, on the 1st July 2024, by order published in the Government Gazette, varied the date of coming into force of the register of electors 2024.

Consequently, the register of electors 2024 will now come into force at the next dissolution of the National Assembly.

THE REPRESENTATION OF THE PEOPLE ACT

Order made by the Electoral Supervisory Commission under Section 39 of the Representation of the People Act

- This order may be cited as the Representation of the People (Variation of Dates) Order, 2024.
- 2. The date set out in the third column of the Schedule to this Order, being the date specified in section 4 of the Representation of the People Act, indicated in the first column of the schedule, shall, in respect of the compilation of the register of electors for every electoral area, be varied in the year 2024, in the manner set out in the fourth column of the schedule.
