NATIONAL ASSEMBLY ELECTIONS 2024

NOTICE TO ELECTORS

The attention of all electors is drawn to the provisions of the Regulations 30 (6) and 30 (7) of the National Assembly Elections Regulations 2014, which read as follows:

Regulation 30 (6):

- (a) No person shall, by means of
 - (i) a camera;
 - (ii) a mobile phone;
 - (iii) a photographic or an electronic device, or any other device through which a photograph may be taken or a video may be made,

take a photograph, or make a video, of a ballot paper, whether the ballot paper is marked or unmarked.

(b) Any person who contravenes paragraph (a) shall commit an offence and shall, on conviction, be liable to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 2 years.

Regulation 30 (7):

- (a) No unauthorized person shall remove a ballot paper out of a voting or counting room.
- (b) No unauthorized person shall, outside a voting or counting room, be found in possession of a ballot paper.
- (c) Any person who contravenes paragraph (a) and (b) shall commit an offence and shall, on conviction, be liable to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 2 years.
